Bid Your welcome, shine Your light.

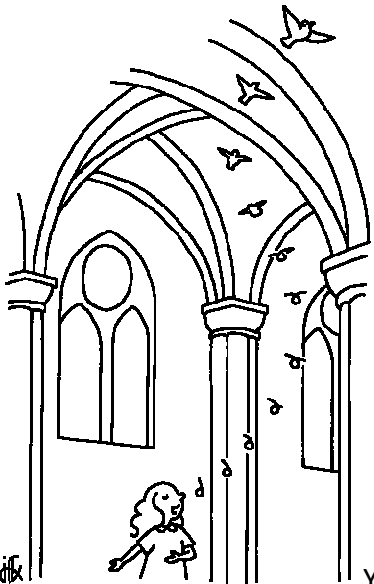
As I marvel at Your moon rise,

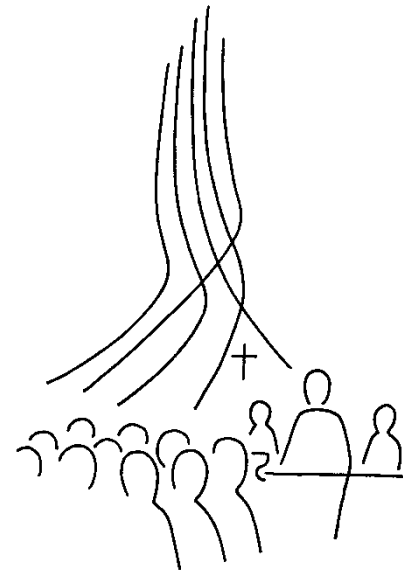
Gather the people! Enter the feast!

So we become what we eat.



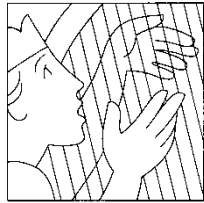

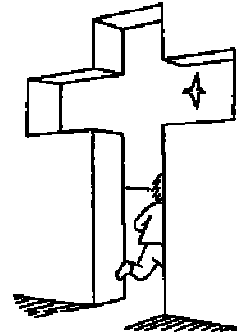

I do Your most holy will.

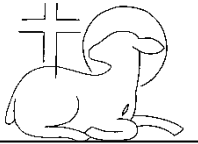


The Mystery of Faith
